

## **Boil Water Notice Rescinded September 12, 2017**

On **September 7, 2017**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required the **South Ellis County Water Supply Corp., PWS ID 0 7000 43**, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

**Customers whose service address is Cosby Rd; West/East Hwy 22, Milford; NWCR 4370; FM 308, Mertens; Richland Bend; and FM 308, Milford are no longer required to boil their water.**

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of **September 12, 2017**.
