

**Boil Water Notice Rescinded
February 19, 2018**

On **February 19**, 2018 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required the **South Ellis County Water Supply Corp., PWS ID 0 7000 43**, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

Primarily customers on the East side of I-35E, served by the 77 Well.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of **February 22, 2018**.
